Nouns	Verbs	Adjectives	Proper Nouns	Pronouns	Rhyming words

Noun = used to name people, animals, things, places, or ideas (butterfly – ball – girl – pirate – school) Verbs = doing or action words (run – jump – bounce – flutter – talk)

Adjectives = describe nouns or pronouns (delicious cake - heavy rain - barren plain - gigantic giraffe)

Proper nouns = the names of specific people, places, or things (Jenny – Mr Jones – Eiffel Tower - England)

Pronouns = used to replace nouns or other pronouns (this, whose, these, it, he, she, they)

Rhyming words = two words that have the same sound when read aloud
