## **School Uniform list**

Navy polo-shirt with gold embroidered school logo

Grey trousers, grey shorts, navy blue skirt or navy-blue pinafore

Black or grey socks (boys)

White or navy socks or navy-blue tights (girls)

Navy blue school jumper or cardigan with gold embroidered school logo.

Navy and white school summer dress (girls)

Please note- School shirts and ties are still an option if you wish, but no longer necessary.

Black school shoes or smaller/simple black boots (not high boots – e.g. Dr Marten style)

School shoes (not trainers), which should be suitable for outdoor play and running, skipping etc.

Loose fitting, high heeled or open toed shoes/sandals are not suitable. Boots in the winter months should be plain, low and with no adornments.
