

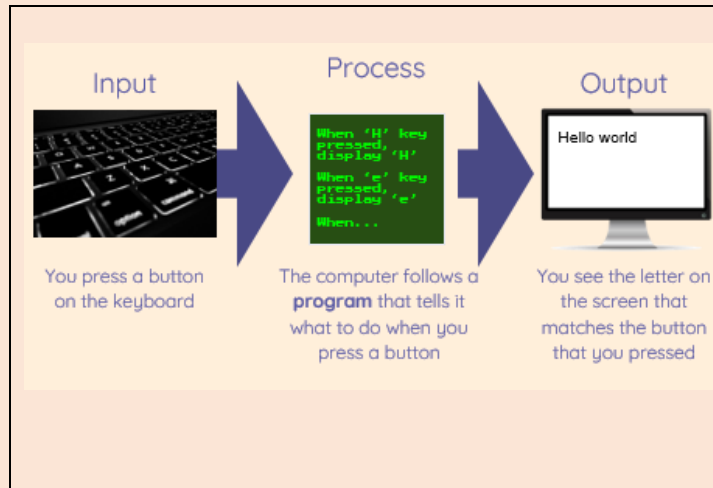
Computer Systems and Photo Editing

digital device	a machine that has a computer inside
input	what is put in, taken in, or operated on by any process or system
output	the amount of something produced by a person or machine
process	a series of actions or steps taken
program	a series of coded software instructions to control the operation of a computer
image	a representation of a person or thing in art
edit	to make changes
arrange	put things in a neat, attractive, or required order
select	carefully choose
crop	to cut something
copyright	legal right to the maker
composition	the preparation of text for printing
pixels	a tiny area of illumination on a display screen, one of many from which an image is composed
rotate	move or cause to move in a circle
flip	to turn over
adjustments	a small alteration or movement made to achieve a desired fit
saturation	the intensity of a colour, expressed as the degree to which it differs from white
sepia	a reddish-brown colour

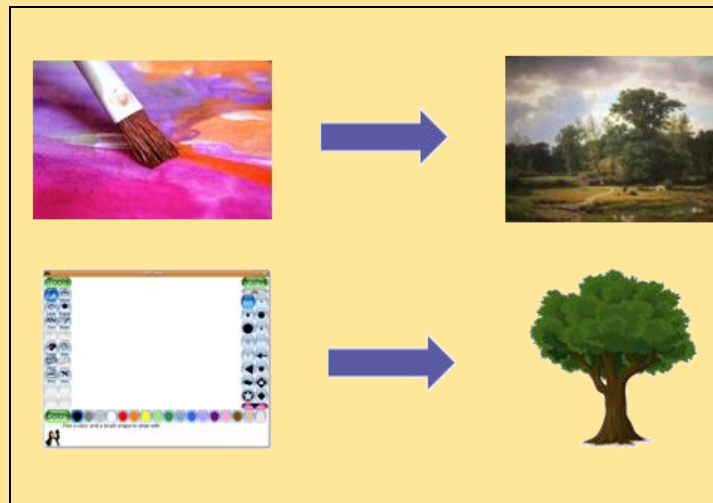
