

Eagle Class Autumn

English

The children will be reading and writing in different genres such explanation writing, folk tales and diary writing. The focus will be on writing at length, using correct punctuation as well as paragraphs and descriptive detail.

Humanities

In history we will be exploring life in Anglo Saxon times. We will look at when and where they lived, what they believed and how they traded. After half term, in Geography we discover the importance of renewable energy focusing on wind power.

French

We will start French after half term. Pupils will begin to say and write sentences which answer questions and include adjectives and adverbs. They will begin to read a non-fiction book in French and improve pronunciation through phonics.

Art

Pupils will explore illustration, looking at new stories and graphic novels. Pupils will create their own character using the computer. After half term pupils will explore global food in DT.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on place value of larger numbers. The year 6's will be working on written methods for multiplication and division. The year 5's will be ordering comparing and rounding larger numbers. They will look at written methods for addition, subtraction and multiplication.

PE

Outdoor games will be with Mr Murnane on a Thursday. They will be improving their throwing, catching and passing skills.

On Fridays they will have swimming lessons, working on stroke techniques and life saving.

Music

This term Eagles will be building on their ukulele skills, extending their knowledge of harmony chords. They will also play singing games to deepen their musician skills and prepare music for the Advent service.

RE

This term we are looking at creation and covenant. Pupils will explore the story of Abraham, faith prayers and the life of Sean Devreaux.

Science

This term the children will be exploring electricity and making circuits. After half term they will explore how plants and animals are classified.

Computing

This term pupils will look at computers and systems. They will look at how people can collaborate together on a task when not physically in the same place. After half term

PSHE

This term we will learn how to debate topics respectively listening to others and expressing opinions. Pupils will explore how to become a global citizen and the importance of democracy.
